

GP Trainers' Commitment to Windsor GP Training Scheme – Updated June 2025

It is recognised that with the increasing pressure on general practice attendance at GP Trainer activities is becoming more difficult. Nevertheless, GP Training requires Trainers to keep up to date with developments, bench-mark their assessments and contribute to the training of Trainees and assessment of Trainers and Practices.

To this end, a minimum commitment for GP Trainers on the Windsor GP Training Scheme was agreed at the Windsor Trainers' Away Days in June 2025.

Activity

1. Essential for functioning of Training Scheme

GP Training Scheme Teaching Session	1 session every 2 years
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2. Essential for functioning of Thames Valley GP School

Trainer re-appraisal	Every 5 years
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3. Continuing Education

Windsor GP Scheme Trainers' Meetings (Need to attend 4 sessions at 3 of the 5 meetings/ year)*	
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Health Education Thames Valley GP School Faculty Day	2 sessions per year
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Nuts and Bolts CBD and Experienced Trainer Course	Both every 5 years
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* Windsor GP Training Scheme Trainers' Meetings:

Four afternoon meetings per year plus a 1.5 day meeting at a 'conference venue' once a year

The agreement was that Trainers should attend 4 sessions per year which should be to at least 3 meetings
